LEGISLATIVE REPORT: The forty-eighth session of the State Legislature ended Tuesday, May 24. Many laws favorable to senior citizens were passed. Time and space will permit only a brief run-down on two of these laws. Others will be covered in later editions.

Substitute House Bill 51 was signed by Governor Spellman. "For those public : employees retired prior to July 1, 1978, the bill will make an increase in monthly retirements of \$0.74 per month for each year of creditable service." It becomes effective July 1, 1983.

Substitute House Bill 496 provides for property-tax relief. It updates the current income levels covered under the program.

Income Level \$14,000 or less per year \$10,000 or less per year

100% exemption from special levies 100% exemption from special levies plus the assessed valuation of the taxpayer's home

Property-tax Exemption

is reduced by \$15,000. The tax relief schedule under SHB 496 for taxes paid in 1984 is:

\$15,000 or less \$12,000 or less

100% exemption from special levies

100% exemption from special levies plus the assessed valuation of the taxpayer's home is reduced by \$20,000.

Your Legislative Committee has copies of these bills and will be glad to give you more details about their provisions.
